



## SURF SURVIVAL/LEARN TO SURF 2021

As part of the schools Surf Survival Program, you must follow instructions given by your supervising teachers as the surf can be dangerous and unpredictable at times. Therefore, if you fail to follow instructions, you will forfeit your position in the program. **Learn to Surf participants must be able to swim 100m and Surf Survival Advanced and Beginners must be able to pass a timed 200m swim test and demonstrate both rescue techniques and first aid/emergency care procedures (Annual requirement).**

You must also be prepared to participate every week, which includes bringing appropriate swimming gear (Beginners and Advanced) and a surfboard with a leg rope or body board with leash and flippers (Advanced Only). **ALL EQUIPMENT IS PROVIDED FOR LEARN TO SURF PARTICIPANTS.**

\*For safety reasons, Advanced students need to wear a **pink vest** whilst in the water (no vest no surfing for safety and legal reasons).
